

The outreach program for this project included two interviews with local newspapers (articles attached). In addition, tours were provided for Cub Scouts and elementary school children. County Marine Extension Agent Jeff Flimlin (Rutgers Cooperative Extension) has an open invitation for tours or information for any interested individuals or groups.

Currently there are tanks set up at a local elementary and high school containing Tilapia grown from the aquaculture system. The high school students have had solar energy instruction incorporated into their curriculum.

Four individuals have been trained in the maintenance of the aquaculture system and have become reliable assistants in its functioning. Various other individuals continue to inquire about and tour the system, which is leading to an increased interest in Aquaculture, of which I am proud to be part of.
