**WHERE TO USE YOUR EBT CARD IN BRATTLEBORO**  
You can use your Vermont Express EBT Card at many grocery stores, convenience stores, markets, and co-ops in the Brattleboro area to buy fresh, unprepared food products.

- USING YOUR EBT CARD AT PARTICIPATING FARMERS' MARKETS**
1. Visit the EBT/Debit Card stand at participating farmer's market
  2. Swipe your EBT card
  3. Receive wooden tokens
  4. Use the wooden tokens to buy fresh, market products



**ELECTRONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER (EBT) CARD**  
EBT (Electronic Benefit Transfer) Cards are a safe, convenient, and easy way for you to use the benefits you receive from the Department for Children and Families. This includes 3SquaresVT, General Assistance, Essential Person Cash Assistance, and Reach Up Financial Assistance.

**HOW IT WORKS**  
You will get a plastic card, called Vermont Express, that looks like a credit card. Each month, your benefits will be automatically added to your account. When you use your card to get cash or buy food, your account balance will decrease accordingly.

- Someone learns your PIN

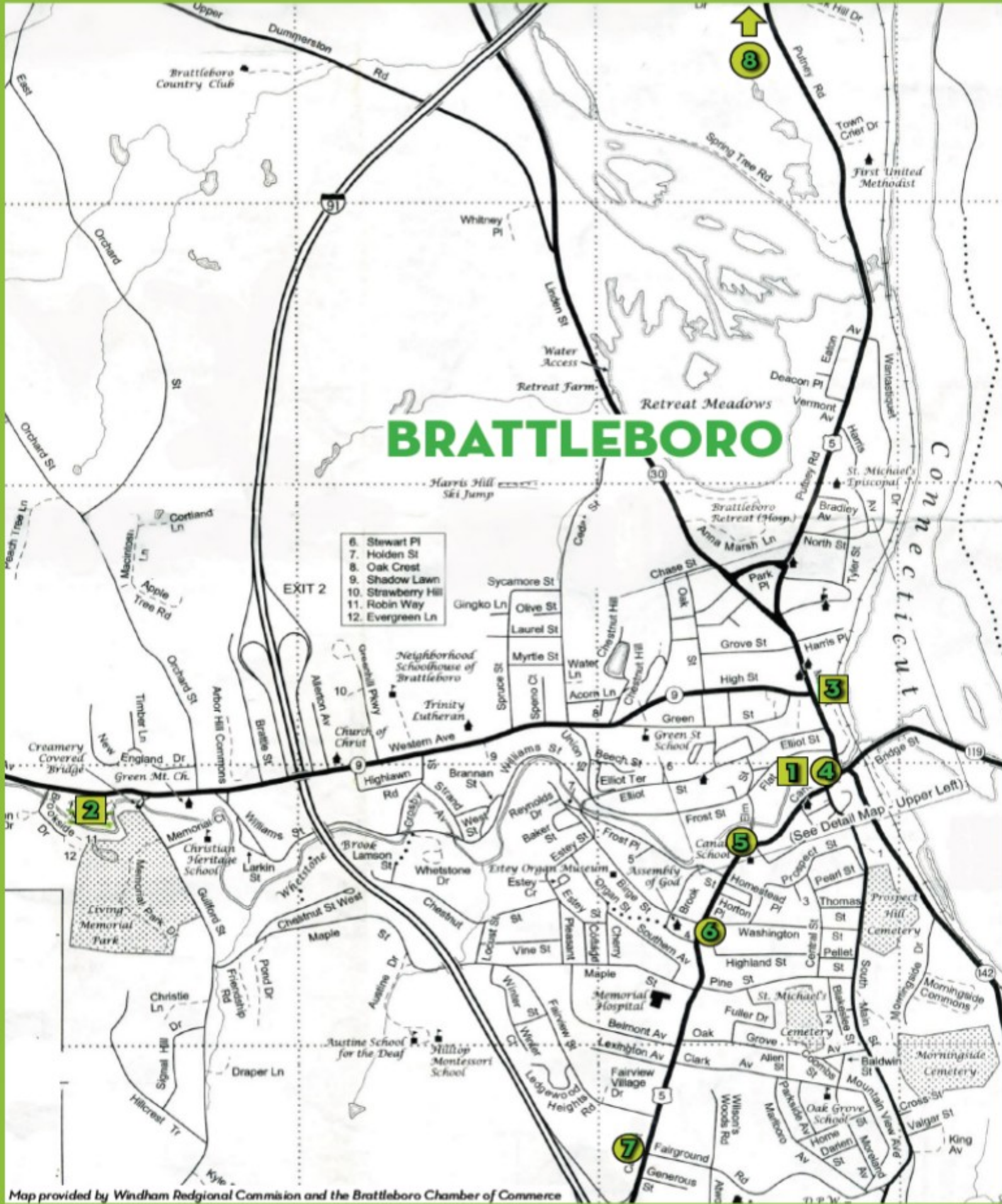
