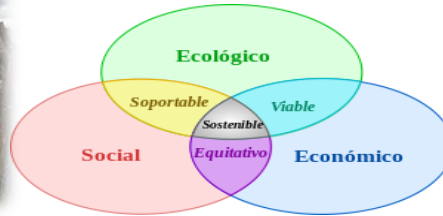


A Farm Visit
